Ictus Solis, which means "Le Coup du Soleil," ("sunburn") was born from the passion of the Vignerons Cooperateurs du Périgord for tradition and innovation.

In the heart of a land bathed by the sun, on the southern slopes of Bergerac, in the south-west of France, Ictus Solis reinvents the millenary art of winemaking, a unique orange wine. VINIFICATION

Orange wine is a maceration wine, like reds, but with white berries. Our Orange wine is a wine made from white Sauvignon gris grapes where the grape skins are not removed, as in typical white wine production, and stay in contact with the juice for weeks.
