

CHÂTEAU PUY SERVAIN CUVEE 178 MONTRAVEL ROUGE



VINEYARD

Château Puy Servain is a family-owned estate belonging to Daniel Hecquet. Since 1943, the estate has been continuously restructured, expanded, and enriched. Puy Servain, whose name comes from "Puy" = summit and "Servain" = tight wind, is located at a very windy peak, at an altitude of 178 meters. The estate spans 3.6 hectares. Low-density vines: 5000 to 7500 vines per hectare.

VINIFICATION

Mechanical harvest with sorting on the table. Aged for 12 months in barrels, 30% of which are new.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Merlot, Cabernet franc

TASTING

A very expressive wine, already delicious to drink, with elegant, smooth tannins and notes of spice, licorice, and chocolate. It can be kept for 5 to 10 years. Serve at a temperature between 10 and 12°C.
